

Retreat with Confidence: The health, safety, and welfare of our guests and staff is of utmost importance. During this time of heightened public health concern, RBC has implemented enhanced cleaning, sanitation and social distancing processes pursuant to guidelines from the Virginia Department of Health.

*All individuals attending a retreat or summer camp must quarantine within their “routine bubble” for 14 days before attending. This is not a strict quarantine - it means that the individual attending will not do anything outside of his/her typical routine (be with family, attend church, etc.). Excluded activities will depend on the household but would include activities such as going on vacation, to an amusement park, etc. The alternative to this type of quarantine is a mandatory COVID test 7 days before attending camp. Test results must be negative prior to arrival.

*All individuals in the group must be free of any symptoms of illness (including cough, fever or chills, headache or body aches, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, vomiting, or diarrhea, rashes) 14 days prior to arrival and through the entirety of your stay. The group leader is expected to monitor this daily. (See [cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov) for more information.)

* Anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days or is awaiting results of a COVID-19 test should not attend.

* Each person will be screened during registration. This will include a list of health questions and a temperature check.

*Please bring your own face masks (you may want to bring a couple per day). We also have face coverings available for purchase in our snack shop. Currently, the Commonwealth of Virginia has ordered that masks are to be worn at all times in all public buildings unless actively eating or drinking or when a person may be within 6 feet of another person outdoors unless an exemption applies.

* There will be adjustments to seating during meals and services.

* Guests will be encouraged to be outside as much as possible to further reduce potential risk of exposure.

* All guests should wash or sanitize their hands before food is served.

* There will be frequent hand washing throughout the day and hand sanitizer stations throughout the camp.

* We will offer activities that can either be cleaned or rested long enough between uses to properly disinfect.

After attending a Retreat:

If you or anyone in your group develops symptoms of COVID-19, and/or tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days after your visit to Rapidan Baptist Camp, please communicate this information to our Director, Mr. Kelly Earles (540-672-0426). We consider informing others as an act of courtesy and kindness out of care for their health.

We are continuing to monitor state guidelines so safety protocols may change. We appreciate your flexibility and understanding to observe these protocols for the safety of yourself, other guests, and our staff.
